sitting in the seat opposite to us.



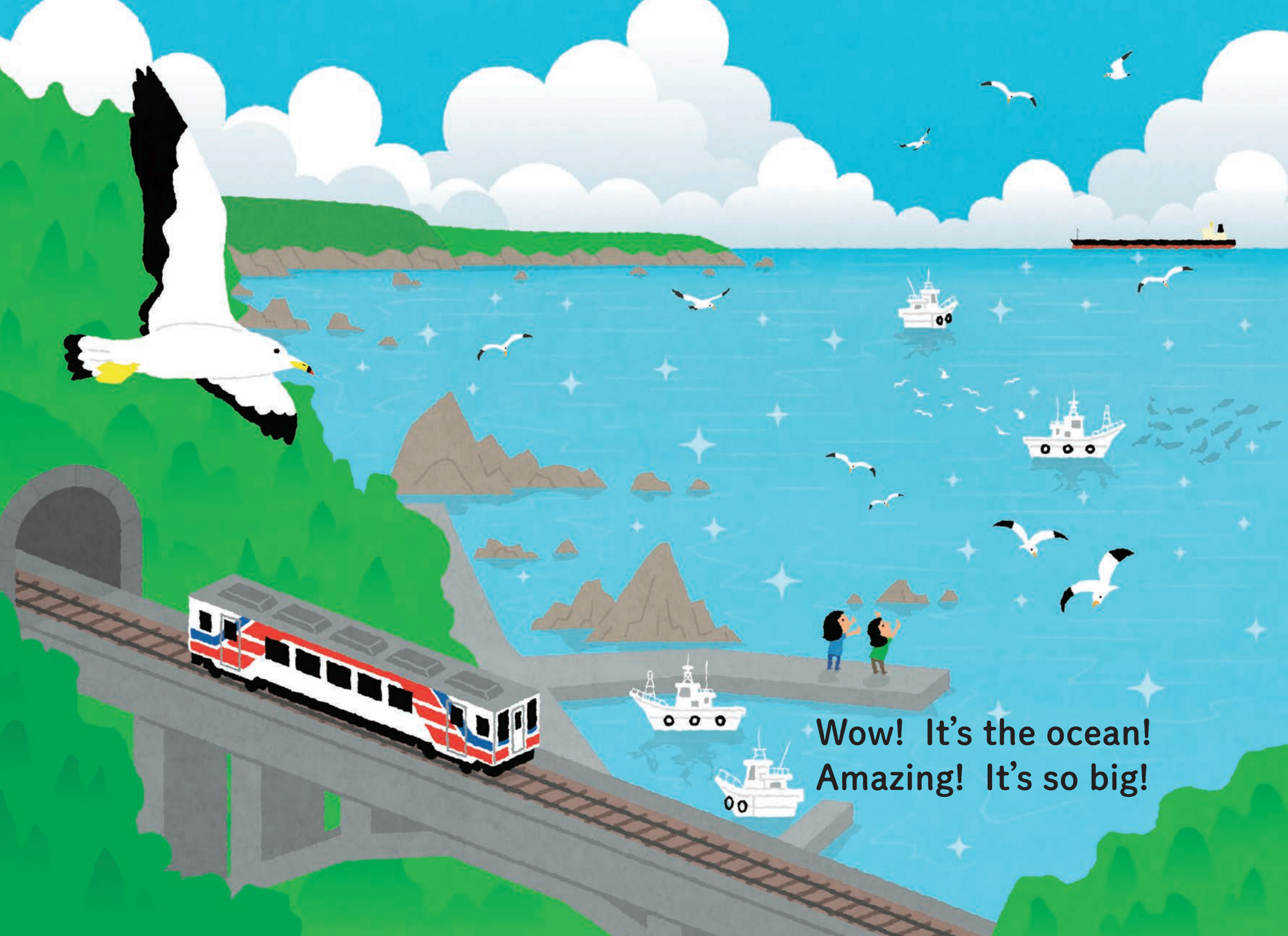
