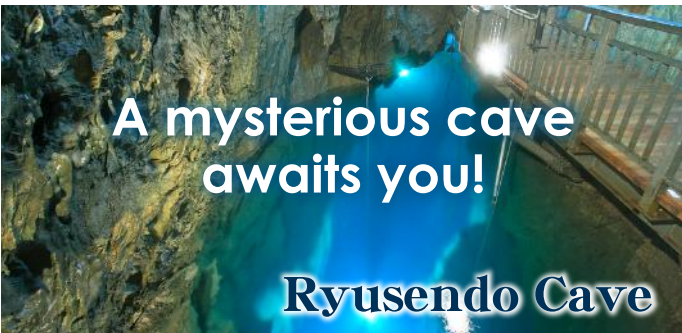

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## Access to tourist spots in Miyako and surrounding areas from Morioka



### From Morioka Station to Miyako City



About 1 hour and 40 mins

Use the 106 express bus (Iwate Kenpoku Bus)



About 2 hours and 30 mins

Use the JR Yamada Line

### From Morioka Station to Ryusendo (Iwaizumi Town)



About 2 hours and 10 mins

Use the buses operated by JR Bus Tohoku

Jodogahama Beach is a famous place in Miyako, known for its clear blue waters and white sandy shores. A small motorboat ("sappa boat") will take you to a magical place called "The Blue Cave," where the reflecting light makes the seawater appear a brilliant blue,

One of Japan's three great limestone caves, and designated as a national treasure. The cave features an underground lake with water that is amongst the most transparent in the world.



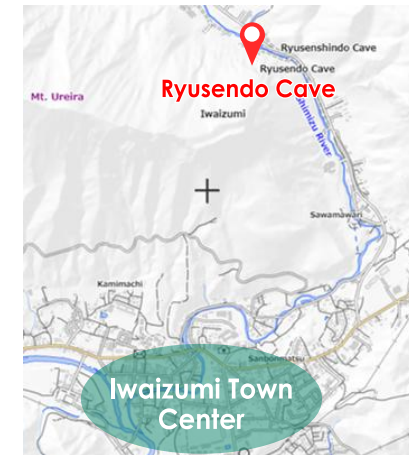

## Recommended Spot: Yamada "Oisuta" Roadside Station

Inside the building, there is a shop selling Yamada Town's local specialties, a restaurant where you can enjoy oysters and other seafood, and a tourist information center.



**Access** Take the bus from Miyako Station and get off at Yanagisawa (about 50 minutes)
